- Free <u>Toolkit for Lawyers at Risk</u> launched on the <u>Day of the Endangered Lawyer</u>, 24 January 2020, jointly produced with the International Bar Association's International Human Rights Institute.
- Publication of LRWC's book, Attacking Defenders: Criminalization of Human Rights Advocacy, free to download and now available free of charge on CanLII.
- Research and a report contributing to the UN Human Rights Committee's 2020 General Comment on <u>freedom of assembly</u>, and the UN's 2020 review of UN human rights <u>treaty bodies' effectiveness</u>.
- Articles in Canadian lawyers' publications to raise awareness about the role of systemic racism in violations of defenders' right to freedom of assembly (in <u>Slaw.ca</u>, a Canadian lawyers online magazine) and the UN *Basic Principles on the Role of Lawyers* (in <u>Slaw.ca</u>) and the situation of endangered lawyers and defenders worldwide in <u>The Advocate</u>, a BC lawyers' magazine.

Advocacy

- Numerous <u>letters and statements</u> calling for protection of human rights lawyers and defenders. LRWC's focus of in 2020-21 is on the rule of law in China, Turkey, the Philippines, Saudi Arabia and Colombia. LRWC volunteers also advocate for defenders in many other countries.
- More than a dozen <u>statements presented at UN Human Rights Council</u> seeking protection of human rights lawyers and defenders in several countries, including China, Iran, the Philippines, Turkey, South Sudan, Sudan, the United States, and Yemen.
