## Re: US Sanctions against the International Criminal Court and its Prosecutor

- Remove all barriers obstructing the administration of justice at the ICC and the independence of the Office of the Prosecutor;
- Establish a cooperative relationship with the ICC and its personnel that respects the international rule of law and the duty of all States to uphold *erga omnes* obligations to prosecute international crimes.

The linked statement provides the background and rational for these recommendations. We look forward to your response.
